

DASP Music Fest 2019 Information Sheet

- There will be scheduled performances for various ensembles taking place in the Theatre and the Spine. All are welcome to attend to watch these.
- There are various workshops taking place in the 6th Form Centre and MU1. Most of these are open to all (adults and children), but you must sign up in advance to take part, via our website. (Percussion workshop, Jazz and Improvisation workshop, Ukulele workshop). A few workshops are for invited students only (Recorder workshop and Pop Choir workshop).
- There is an open ‘busking’ session in the Spine. Please sign up in advance via the website to gain a ‘busking’ slot. These slots are suitable for all genres of music. There will be a piano keyboard provided but no drum kit (so it is not suitable for bands).
- There is an ‘open mic’ session being held outside. Please sign up in advance via the website to take an ‘open mic’ slot. These slots are suitable for singers and guitarists. There will be no piano or drumkit outside, but there will be amps, mics and a backing track facility.
- There are two ‘Come and Try’ sessions when children can come and have a go on a variety of instruments with guidance from various DASP teachers. No need to book – just turn up!
- There are two short DO RE MI Time sessions for Key Stage 1 children. Please sign up in advance via the website.
- There are various events that we would like to invite people to just turn up and take part in (no signing up necessary). These are the Barn Dance and the Big Sing. As part of the Big Sing, we will teach you the anthem that will form part of the large-scale “Apollo – One Giant Leap” performance at Maumbury Rings on 19th July (a free event, which the whole town is invited to!). We would then love everyone to stay after the Big Sing to hear the THS Concert Band provide the finale of the festival.
- In addition to the scheduled sessions, there will be music stalls from various music shops including John Packers Woodwind and Brass specialists, food and drink stalls, ice-cream, raffle and more!
