



**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF DASP ENSEMBLES**  
**2018/2019**

**Arrangement of Ensembles:**

All ensembles are coordinated and arranged through DASP Music.

**Ensemble sessions:**

All ensembles will run for a minimum of **nine** sessions per term. These sessions will be published at the start of the term. If due to unforeseen circumstances, sessions need to be cancelled, we will endeavor to give as much notice as possible and will contact you by email or by phone. One session per term may be turned into an 'open rehearsal' or performance for family and friends.

**Payment for Ensembles:**

You will be billed directly by DASP Music for membership of all ensembles. The fees are charged termly per student and bills will be issued at the start of each term. Fees for 2018-19 are as follows:

One ensemble = £30 per term

Two ensembles = £50 per term

Three or more ensembles = £70 per term

**Fees will need to be paid by BACS by the dates specified on your bill.**

**Attendance:**

**If your son/daughter is unable to attend a rehearsal, please let the director know either via the DASP Music Office or personally to the Ensemble Director wherever possible.** We are unable to provide refunds when the teacher is available and the student is absent for whatever reason (including sickness, holidays, lateness or forgetfulness!).

**Stopping Membership:**

If your son/daughter wishes to discontinue membership for any reason, please be aware that the DASP Music Office requires notice in writing.

**Financial Support:**

We provide free ensemble places for all children who are in receipt of 'free school meals' via Pupil Premium funding – please tell us on the application form if this is the case.

Our aim is that all children can access our ensembles, without being inhibited by financial constrictions. If your son/daughter does not receive pupil premium funding, but you will struggle to pay the full amount to join an ensemble, then DASP Music does have funding options which we can consider. Please contact us directly if this is the case to confidentially explain your situation. Each application will be considered independently.
